George B. Quisenberry, 74, of 2914 Macon St., South Charleston, died Sunday June 17 in Thomas Memorial Hospital after a short illness.

He was a retired bookkeeper for Union Carbide with 29 years service and had worked as manager of the credit union for South Charleston Carbide employees for 10 years. He was a member and deacon emeritus of the First Baptist Church, South Charleston where he had been financial secretary for 15 years, a Sunday school teacher and youth counselor. He was South Charleston city clerk for two years.
