Ira Webb, 85, of 421 Ballengee St., died 1:20 p.m. Wed. Mar. 24, 1993, in a Beckley hospital, following a short illness.

Born Nov. 20, 1907, at Bertha, he was the son of the late John Webb and Ollie Barker Webb Pittman.

Mr. Webb lived most of his life in Summers County. He was the president and chairman of the board of directors of the First National Bank of Hinton, a member of the First Presbyterian Church, Hinton, a World War II veteran, a retired merchant and realtor and a member of the Hinton Elks Lodge.

He was preceded in death by his wife, Wilma Fredeking Webb, in 1980; six brothers and three sisters.

He was the last surviving member of his immediate family.

Survivors include several nieces and nephews.

Services were held at 2 p.m. Sat. Mar. 27 at First Presbyterian Church, Hinton, with the Rev. Robert Glaser officiating. Burial followed in the Restwood Memorial Gardens, Hinton.

The body was at the Ronald Meadows Funeral Parlors and at the church.
