### **Eugene Crookshanks Dies In Charleston**

Engene Crookshanks, 30, of 446 19th street, Dunbar, son of Mr. and Mrs. I. W. Crookshanks, of this city, died Monday in a Charleston hospital after a long illness. He was a graduate of the 1933 class at Hinton high school, a former student at a Knoxville, Tenn., military school and at the Charleston School of Commerce. He was employed in the office at the Carbide and Carbon plant. He was a member of Phi Theta Pi, commercial fraternity, and of the Hinton Methodist church.

Surviving are the wife, Mrs. Mary Wilson Dotson Crookshanks; the parents, Mr. and Mrs. I. W. Crookshanks, of Hinton; a sister, Miss Mildred, of Charleston, and three brothers, Edward Crookshanks, of San Francisco, Calif.; Robert, of the U. S. army, and Wilbur Crookshanks, of Whitesville.

Services were held at 9 o'clock this (Wednesday) morning at Barlow's funeral chapel, Rev. Joe B. Overmyer officiating, and additional services were held at the graveside in the Lewisburg cemetery with Rev. Paul L. Flanagan, of Rainelle, and Rev. Lloyd Courtney, of Lewisburg, officiating.
