Mrs. Betty Ann Hutchison Whitman, 87, of Ozark, Alabama, died Sunday, January 6, 2008, in Ozark Health and Rehabilitation Center following an extended illness.

A memorial service was held at 10 a.m. Friday, January 11, from Ozark Presbyterian Church with the Reverend Randall Yelverton officiating. The family received friends in the church following the service.

Interment for Mrs. Whitman was in Elkins, West Virginia, Holman Funeral Home of Ozark handled local arrangements.

Mrs. Whitman was born in Hinton to Verna Day Hutchison and William E. Hutchison. She was retired from the Westinghouse Corporation in Maryland where she previously resided.
