

Worth Hobson Wray

September 23, 1899 – October 19, 1933

Worth H. Wray, 34 years old, died unexpectedly Thursday morning, of heart disease. He came to this city from Virginia and graduated from the Hinton high school in 1918.

He was a deacon in the First Baptist church, a member of the choir of that church, and a member of the Hinton Kiwanis club.

Mr. Wray is survived by his widow, the former Miss Isabelle Bruce; one son, Charles, and a daughter, Anne, three years old. His mother, Mrs. R. H. Peterson, of Hinton, and the following brothers and sisters: T. C. Wray, of Needles, Calif.; Mrs. Drinkwater, Los Angeles; Mrs. F. W. Pierce, of Clendenin, and Roy and Harry Wray, of Beckley.
