Mrs. Carrie Graham Reardon, 86, died Thursday in a Mount Lake Park, Md., nursing home after a long illness.

Born March 21, 1895, in Hinton, she was a daughter of the late Luther P. and Jennie Mae Hamer Graham.

Mrs. Reardon was a member of the St. Stephen's Episcopal Church in Beckley; a retired Raleigh County school

president of the retired Raleigh County Teachers Association.

She was a volunteer at the Beckley Veterans Administration Medical Center and a 50-year member of the American Red Cross, Youth Glades Chapter, Daughters of the American Revolution, and a member of the Garrett County Woman's Republican Club.

Her husband, Robert Lee Reardon, died April 19, 1962.

Survivors include a daughter, Mrs. William (Virginia) Stemple of Mount Lake Park, Md.; a brother, Ernest Graham of Pompano Beach, Fla., and two grandchildren.

Services were held Sunday at 2 p.m. in the Melton Mortuary chapel in Beckley with the Rev. Howard G. Backus officiating. Burial followed in the Sunset Memorial Park.
