P. Bigony Dies; Rites Incomplete

HINTON (RNS) — Phillip Norman Bigony, 51, died at 3 p.m. Saturday at the home of an aunt, Miss Sallie Charlton, Park Ave.

He had made his home with her for several years. Death was attributed to a heart attack. He had been in ill health for several years.

Born in Hinton, May 1, 1907, he was a son of the late Dr. J. F. and Mattie Charlton Bigony. He was a graduate of Hinton High School, attended Berea College, Berea, Ky., and completed a business course at Mountain State Business College, Parkersburg.

He worked for a period of time as a bookkeeper in the old Citizens National Bank.

Survivors include two brothers, J. Clair, Hinton, and P. E., Orange Fla. and one sister, Mrs. Louise Beckle, Fort Worth, Tex.
