R. R. Maddy, 26, Is Slain In Ohio

HINTON (RNS) — Robert Ray Maddy, 26, of Cleveland, Ohio, was found shot to death Sunday in a Cleveland alley.

Maddy, formerly of Hinton, was shot once in the chest. He was sprawled beside his car. Police found the engine running and the headlights on.

Detectives said he stopped in a west side bar early Sunday after leaving his job as an electrician at the Jones & Laughlin Steel Corp.

Police discounted robbery as a motive for the shooting. They said Maddy had in his pockets a \$105 paycheck and \$9 in cash. A resident heard the shot and called police.

Maddy was the son of William Ray and Marguerite Woodrum Maddy of 700 Summers St., Hinton.

Born Jan. 14, 1938 at Hinton, he was a member of the Community Christian Church of Hinton, the Men's Bible Class, Hinton Moose Lodge and the Veterans of Foreign Wars Post of Cleveland.

The body will arrive in Hinton Tuesday morning. It will be taken to the E. M. Meadows Funeral Home. Arrangements are incomplete.

Services Thursday For Robert Maddy

HINTON (RNS) — Funeral services for Robert Ray Maddy, 26, of Cleveland, Ohio, formerly of Hinton, will be conducted at 2 p.m. Thursday in the E. M. Meadows Funeral Home at Hinton with the Rev. J. F. Atkins and the Rev. Fred Dillon in charge. Burial will be in the Fairview Baptist Church Cemetery at Forest Hill.

Maddy was shot and killed in Cleveland Sunday morning.

The body will arrive in Hinton today and friends may call at the funeral home this afternoon.

Cousins will serve as pallbearers.
