## Mannix Services

Funeral services will be held at 9 a. m. Friday at the Saint Francis de Sales Catholic Church with the Rev. John Halpin officiating for Mrs. Margaret Fitzpatrick Mannix, 63, wife of J. M. Mannix, who died early yesterday at her home at 502 North Kanawha Street. Burial will follow in Sunset Memorial Park.

The body will be removed from the Keyser Funeral Home to the residence at 4 p. m.

A roomer at the Mannix home found the body in the kitchen about 2 o'clock and called a local physician. The husband, a court bailiff, was away at the time on a trip to Greenbrier County and did not return until about 7 p. m.

She had been ill for some time but was not in a serious condition and was not confined to bed. Born in Hinton, she was a daughter of the late Timothy and Catherine Fitzpatrick, and had been a Raleigh County resident for the past 27 years. She was a member of St. Francis de Sales Church and Catholice Daughters.

Survivors, in addition to her husband; include four sons, W. Edward Mannix, of Beckley; Joe M. Mannix, Jr., of Washington, D. C.; Lt. Paul F. Mannix, stationed at a Navy Air Base in Atlantic City, N. J.; and Thomas E. Mannix, a student at West Virginia University, Morgantown.

Also surviving are a sister, Miss Clara Fitzpatrick, of Charleston, and five grandchildren.
