### FUNERAL SERVICES ARE HELD THIS AFTERNOON FOR MRS. FITZSIMMONS

Funeral services were conducted this afternoon at two o'clock at the Ascension Episcopal church for Mrs. Zephia B. Fitzsimmons, 70, wife of J. P. Fitzsimmons, who died in the Hinton Hospital Sunday morning at 5:20 a.m. following a two year illness.

The rector, Rev. J. W. Ware, Jr., officiated and burial followed in the Restwood Memorial Estates.

Born at Stonecliff, Mrs. Fitzsimmons was a daughter of the late Lucian and Eliza Crawford Woolwine and had resided in Hinton since 1929. In her early life she attended school in Hinton and was employed for a time as a clerk for the C&O Railway Company at Huntington. She also served as a clerk in the local postoffice.

She was an active member of the Episcopal church as long as health permitted and was a member of the Woman's Auxiliary, Guild, Hinton Woman's Club, Delphi Club and the Garden Club.

Survivors besides her husband include two sons by a former marriage, Henry Kinney of Fort Lauderdale, Florida and Gordon Kinney of White Plains, N. Y.; one sister, Mrs. Harlowe Ollom of Montgomery and three granddaughters.

Pallbearers named for the service were G. S. Alderson, Jr., Harold E. Neely, Harold Beasley, Dr. A. P. Meador, James Fitzsimmons, William Fitzsimmons, J. W. McCallister, Jr., and John E. Faulconer.

The body remained at the E. M. Meadows Funeral Home on Park Avenue until the funeral hour.
