### **SANFORD STEVENS HAMER**

Sanford Stevens Hamer, 74, of 2505 Liberty Road, Greensboro, beloved husband, father and grandfather, went to be with the Lord Monday, Aug. 21, 2000, at Moses Cone Hospital, after a long illness.

He was born Dec. 17, 1925, in Hinton, a son of Roxton Leland and Clara Faye Stevens Hamer. He was an employee of AT&T, Greensboro and Winston-Salem, before retiring after 34 years of service. He was a veteran of World War II, having served in the Pacific Theatre, in the U. S. Marine Corps. He was a member of Cloverdale Baptist Church, High Point, where he had previously served as a deacon. On Sept. 8, 1944, he was married to the former Mildred Lilly, who survives of the home.

Also surviving are two daughters, Linda H. Cook and husband, Eric and Nancy H. Cook and husband, Mitchell, all of Greensboro; one grandson; and five step-grandchildren.
