Prominent Charleston Doctor, Surgeon Dies

Charleston, W. Va., Dec. 31 (AP) Dr. Ernest Fred Gott, 63, prominent surgeon and one-time chief surgeon of Kanawha valley hospital here, died today at his summer residence at St. Albans.

He had been practicing in the Charleston area since 1923, and also was a former examining physician for the state workmen's compensation department.

A native of Hinton, Dr. Gott served as an army surgeon aboard a transport ship in World War I. He moved from Princeton to St. Albans in 1919 and came to Charleston four years later.
