Harry Fletcher Damron, 85, of Portsmouth, Va., passed away, November 25, 2000. He was born and grew up in Hinton. He received his undergraduate degree from Marshall University and postgraduate studies at Harvard.

He was retired from the U. S. Government after 30 years service, achieving "Super Grade" level. During his tenure with the government in Washington, D.C., he served as Head of Navigational Instrument Design Bureau; Head of Advance Concepts Bureau; and Deputy Director of Surveillance, Command & Control and Communication Division for the U. S. Navy Department.
