NORA NILE NEELY SUCCUMBS AFTER 12 DAY ILLNESS

HINTON — Miss Nora Nile Neely, aged 24 years, daughter of Joseph R. and the late Mrs. Neely, of Grace street, died at 2:10 o'clock Thursday afternoon in the Hinton hospital following an illness of 12 days. She was taken to the hospital in a critical condition last Tuesday.

Born in Hinton, she attended local schools and graduated from the Hinton high school. She had been employed as secretary in the local office of the Farm Security Administration for several years. A member of the First Baptist church, the Rebekah lodge and the Degree of Honor, she was widely and favorably known among the younger social circles.

Funeral arrangements were incomplete Thursday afternoon. Burial will be made in the family cemetery at old Neely home place near True.

She is survived by her father, and four brothers: Russell Neely, of Richmond, Va., Robert Neely, of Seattle, Wash., Julian Neely, of the U. S. army in France, and Joe B. Neely, at home.
