Elsie Marie Burrows, 87, of 220 Ballengee St., Hinton, died Tuesday, Feb. 10, 1998 in a Princeton hospital following a long illness.

Born Feb. 1, 1911, in Johnson City, Tenn., she was the daughter of the late Henry Folsom and Margaret Ellen Hayes Burrow.

Miss Burrows was a graduate of Hinton High School, and the Medical College of Virginia School of Nursing in Richmond, VA., and completed her graduate work at Columbia University in New York City.

She worked on the staff and in Administration as Director of Nurses at Manhattan Ear, Eye Nose, and Throat Hospital, and Lenox Hill Hospital in New York City. After retirement in New York she returned to West Virginia where she worked with her brother-in-law, Dr. Buford W. McNeer until his death in 1981.

While in New York she was a member of St. James Episcopal Church and Alter Guild and was a member of Ascension Episcopal Church in Hinton, where she served as a member of the Vestry.

She was preceded in death by a brother, Fred N. Burrow in 1962.

Survivors include two sisters Ruth B. Willis of McLean, VA., and Anna Mae McNeer of Hinton; two nephews, Dr. Michael D. McNeer of Hinton, and Robert C. Willis of Richmond, VA., a niece, Mary Ellen Howard of McLean, VA.; seven grandnephews; two grandnieces; and one great-grandniece.

Services were held at 2 p. m. Fri., Feb. 13th. at the Ascension Episcopal Church, Hinton, with the Rev. Herb S. Ellison officiating. Burial followed in the Greenbrier Burial Park, Hinton.
