Mrs. Maude Boyd Taken By Death

HINTON, Dec. 5 — Mrs. Maude Boyd, wife of N. O. Boyd, of Bellepoint, died at her home at 7:15 o'clock this morning. In declining health for several years, her condition became critical Monday.

She was born at Lowell, Aug. 21, 1890, a daughter of the late John and Emma Bush Willey, and had resided in Summers County all her life, the last 40 years in Hinton and Bellepoint.

A former teacher in the city and county schools, she retired in 1946, after 28 years of service. She was a member of the Central Baptist Church and the Ladies Auxilliary of the B. of R. T.

In addition to her husband, she is survived by a son, John Boyd, of Williamson, two brothers: Arthur Willey, of Bellepoint, and Guy Willey, and two grandchildren.

Funeral services will be conducted at 2 o'clock Sunday afternoon by the Rev. H. P. Hackney. The body will remain at the Ronald Meadows Funeral parlors.
