Former Resident Dies In Mississippi

Fulton Ballard Ryalls, “Skip” as he was known by his many elderly Hinton friends passed away on December 19, 2000 at a Care Home near his residence in Hurley, Mississippi.

Mr. Ryalls was the son of the late Eugene Litch Ryalls and Christine Ballard Ryalls and was a 1941 graduate of Hinton High School.

Skip left Hinton in the mid-50's after having worked for the railroad a short while before and after his military service.

He worked for Colgate Corp. for many years and after retirement located in Florida a few years then finally locating in Frankford, WV for a number of years. Due to declining health he and his wife moved to Hurley where his wife was able to get some assistance from her family in his care.

He is survived by his wife, Cheryl L. Ryalls of Hurley; a daughter, Sharon Ryalls of Alison Park, PA.; two sons, Bruce Ryalls of Jacksonville, Fla., and Barry Ryalls of Charlotte, N.C., five grandchildren and one sister, Madeline Ryalls Stone and her husband, Bill of Clifton Forge, VA.
