Herbert Vass, 60, of 506 Ballengee Street died Tuesday May 25 in the Summers County Hospital.

Born in Hinton December 16, 1921, he was a son of the late Walter H. and Lena Wilson Vass.

Mr. Vass retired June 1979 from the Veterans Administrative Hospital in Beckley and later transferred to the Federal Correctional Institute in Alderson. He was a member of the Central Baptist Church, Hinton Elk Lodge No. 821, Willowwood Country Club, Veteran of World War II, and also a member of the V.F.W. He lived all of his life in Hinton.
