Retired Brigadier General Edward Lee Gill, 69, of Frankfort, KY, formerly of Hinton, died Sunday, Dec. 23, 2001, in St. Joseph Hospital in Lexington, Ky., following a long illness.

Born in Hinton, he was the son of the late Edward and Bertie Hatcher Gill.

Mr. Gill was retired from the Kentucky Army National Guard and was a veteran of the Korean Conflict. He was a member of the Buck Run Baptist Church.

He was preceded in death by one brother, Danny Gill; and one sister, Carol Burg.
