PAUL HEFLIN DEAD

From last Thursday's Daily.

According to information received here, today, by Mrs Sites, Paul Heflin, who was reported some days ago as severely wounded in the chest while fighting with the British in Belgium on Oct. 18th, succumbed on Oct. 25th. He died in the British casualty clearing station. The first news of his dangerous condition was given in a letter from a nurse to his parents, Judge and Mrs. A. R. Heflin, now of New York City, but formerly of this city.

Paul Heflin was about 22 years of age and was reared in Hinton where he is pleasantly remembered by all. He, also, has died for the cause of justice and civilization that the star of liberty might continue to illuminate.

His sorrow-stricken parents have the sympathy of their many Hinton friends in the great bereavement that has overtaken them in the loss of their youngest boy.
