Thomas (Tom) E. Ball, 74, of 114 Central Avenue, died Sunday, June 5, at a Hinton hospital.

Born September 25, 1913, in Summers County, he was the son of the late James O. and Ethel S. Richmond Ball.

Mr. Ball was a life-long resident of Summers County, was retired from Hinton Builders Supply Co. after 45 years of service, and was a member of the Brooklyn United Methodist Church and the military affiliate Radio Systems.

He was also a World War II Navy veteran, was active as an operator and instructor in amateur radio, was secretary - treasurer of the Hinton Sanitary Board, and was a former Hinton city council member.

He was preceded in death by three brothers.
