Richard P Baylor, 82, of Hinton, died at his home Thursday, November 15, 2007.

Born in Summers County, W.Va., May 1, 1925, he was the son of the late Lewis W. and Birdie (McCreery) Baylor.

Mr. Baylor served his country in the U.S. Marine Corps during World War II and in the U.S. Air Force during the Korean conflict. He was a school teacher, wholesale beer distributor; and member of West Virginia State Senate 10th District, from 1977 to 1982. Richard was an Episcopalian, member of the Elks, Moose, American Legion, Veterans of Foreign Wars, Disabled American Veterans, and Marine Corps League.
