Theodore “Ted” Martufi, 83, of 440 Wilson Court, Huntington, West

Virginia, died Saturday November 21, 1987, in a Huntington hospital. Wake was held at 8 p.m. Monday, November 23 at 8 p.m. at the Reger Funeral Home. Mass of Christian Burial was conducted at 10 a.m. Tuesday, November 24 at St. Joseph’s Catholic Church by the Rev. Father Harold W. Moore. Entombment was in the Ridgelawn Memorial Park.

He was born April 4, 1904, in Hinton, West Virginia, a son of the late Nazezerno and Leona Fioni Martufi. He was a disabled veteran of World War II in the U. S. Army in Europe.

He was a member of St. Joseph’s Catholic Church. He graduated from Marshall University and Georgetown University Law School.

He was preceded in death by his wife, Marjorie Steele Martufi; one sister, Mary M. Mills; and two brothers, Ernest P. Martufi and Henry Martufi.
