Donald W. Honaker, 71, died Tuesday, July 7, at a Fairlea hospital following a short illness.

Born July 3, 1916, at Hinton, he was the son of the late H. W. and Susan Wilson Honaker.

Mr. Honaker was a member of the St. James Episcopal Church at Lewisburg and a retired employee of DuPont. He was a member of the Greenbrier Lodge 42 AF & AM, the Ronceverte Chapter 21 Royal Arch Masons, the Greenbrier Commandry 15 Knights of Pythias and the Scottish Rites of Free Masonry.
