

Wilma Ferne Fredeking Webb

Mrs. Wilma Ferne Webb, 67, of 421 Ballengee St. died Thursday at 5:45a.m. in a Hinton Hospital after a long illness.

Born December 4, 1912, in Hinton, she was a daughter of the late Herbert Fredeking and Vera Halloran Fredeking Johnson.

Mrs. Webb, a lifelong resident of Hinton, was owner of the former Fredeking Jewelry and Hinton Floral stores, having retired in 1963.

A graduate of Hinton High School and Dunsmore Business College at Staunton, VA, she was a member of the First Presbyterian Church in Hinton, former member of Hinton Services Club, the Wednesday Club, and the Business and Professional Women's Club.

Her stepfather, Lawin A. Johnson, preceded her in death.

Survivors include her husband, Ira Webb.

Funeral services were held Saturday at 2p.m. in the First Presbyterian Church with the Rev. Tom Johnson and Stewart McMurray officiating. Burial followed in the Restwood memorial Gardens.
