MRS. SNUFFER DEATH VICTIM

HINTON, May 12 — Mrs. Carlyle Snuffer, 18, the former Miss Mary Helen Honaker, daughter of Mrs. O. E. Honaker, of Pipestem, died in a Baltimore hospital Monday night following childbirth. The baby died shortly after birth.

Mr. and Mrs. Honaker were both former residents of Pipestem, and members of the 1948 graduating class of Hinton high school. Mr. Honaker has been employed in Baltimore.

In addition to her husband and mother, she is survived by three brothers: J. D., Ronnie and Billie Ray Honaker, all at home; her maternal grandparents, Mr. and Mrs. E. D. Cook, of Pipestem; her paternal grandfather, E. A. Honaker, of Bellepoint.

Complete funeral arrangements could not be learned here. Burial will be made at Princeton at 2:00 o'clock Sunday afternoon, with the Cook Funeral Home, of Nitro, in charge.

The body of the baby arrived at the Barnett funeral home here today and will remain there until the arrival of the mother sometime tomorrow. Both bodies will then be removed to the home of her parents at Pipestem.
