Harry M. Hoover, 84, died Thursday May 13, after a long illness.

Born July 23, 1897, in Hinton, he was a son of the late George S. and Rose Altare Hoover.

Mr. Hoover was a lifelong resident of Hinton, a member and deacon of the Central Baptist Church in Hinton and a retired C&O Railway clerk and a World War I veteran.

A son, Harry E. Ned Hoover, died September 1972.

Survivors include his wife, Edith Mayes Hoover; four grandchildren and two great grandchildren.

Services were held Sunday May 16 at 2 p.m. at the Central Baptist Church in Hinton with Dr. Robert Keaton officiating. Burial followed in the Hilltop Cemetery.
