# Nathan (Bunny) Anderson Dies Unexpectedly Today

Nathan Leonard Anderson, 41, widely known Hinton resident, died unexpectedly this morning at 6:15 o'clock in the Hinton Hospital of a coronary occlusion after he had suffered a heart attack Wednesday afternoon at his camp on the Greenbrier River, a short distance above the Willow Wood bridge.

Mr. Anderson was first stricken while working around his camp, however following that attack he drove his car to his home here on Fifth Avenue, and was removed to the hospital Thursday morning.

A second attack was suffered in the hospital this morning at 1:15 o'clock, and he died at the hour stated.

Mr. Anderson was born and reared in Hinton, being a son of the late A. B. Anderson and Mrs. Mary Meadows Anderson. At the time of his death he was employed as a salesman for the Bowers Coffee Company and Mohr Brokerage Company.

"Bunny", as he was known to his many friends here, was a graduate of the Hinton High School and of Marshall College in 1938 where he was a member of the Alpha Kappa Pi fraternity.

Following his graduation from college he served in the medical corp during World War II in the European Theatre.

Mr. Anderson was an active member of the Hinton Elks Lodge and was an ardent sport fan.

Besides his mother, he is survived by a sister Mrs. Mary Lee Rudge of Lawton, Oklahoma.

Funeral arrangements are incomplete today, but will be in charge of the E. M. Meadows Funeral Home.
