Mrs. Merritt D. Holstein, 78, died Monday, March 30, at 10 p.m. at a Hilldale care center following a long illness.

Born June 24, 1908, at Hinton, she was the daughter of the late John T. and Lillie E. Wysong Day.

Mrs. Holstein lived most of her life at Hinton, was former owner of Holstein Chevrolet at Hinton and was a member of the First Presbyterian Church at Hinton. She was a former member of the Delphia Club, the Service Club and the Hinton Woman's Club. She was a former volunteer for the Bookmobile.

She was preceded in death by her husband, John W. Holstein in 1968.

Survivors include a daughter, Mrs. W. G. (Joyce) Meador of Hinton; a son, John D. Holstein of Princeton, and three grandchildren.

Services were held Thursday April 2 at 2 p.m. at the First Presbyterian Church at Hinton with Chaplain Dean Veltman and the Rev. Stuart McMurray officiating. Burial followed in the Greenbrier Burial Park.

The body was at the Ronald Meadows Funeral Parlors in Hinton and at the church one hour prior to services.

Men of the church served as pallbearers.
