TUESDAY 2 P.M.

Funeral services will be held Tuesday at 2 p.m. in the First Presbyterian Church for John M. Cobb, 60, life-long and well known Hinton resident who died Sunday at 8:10 a.m. in the Hinton Hospital after a six-week's illness.

The Rev. Stewart McMurray and the Rev. G. O. Tease will officiate with burial to follow in the Greenbrier Burial Park.

Born in Hinton, August 2, 1902, Cobb was a son of the late Albert and Cora Mann Cobb.

He was a graduate of the Davis and Elkins College at Elkins and the Union Seminary in Richmond, Va., and was employed as electrician for the Chesapeake and Ohio Railway Company.

The deceased was a member and elder of the First Presbyterian Church in Hinton and member of Hinton Masonic Lodge No. 62.

Surviving are his wife, Mrs. Hallie Martin Cobb; one daughter, Mrs. Richard Gunnoe of White Sulphur Springs; two grandchildren and a brother, L. C. Cobb of Greenbelt, Md.

The body will remain at the Ronald Meadows Funeral Parlors until one hour before the service when it will be taken to the church. Members of the Masonic Lodge will serve as pallbearers and conduct graveside rites.
