Death Takes Dr. Litsinger

Dr. Edward A. Litsinger, a Charleston physician for 30 years and superintendent of Spencer State Hospital for eight years, died Sunday in Jackson General Hospital, Ripley.

Dr. Litsinger, 67, of Cedarcrest Drive in Ripley, practiced medicine here for 30 years before being named superintendent of the state hospital in 1958. He retired in 1966.

He was a member of the Kanawha County, West Virginia and American Medical Societies and belonged to the American Psychiatric Association. Dr. Litsinger attended Randolph-Macon College in Ashland, Va. and was a graduate of West Virginia University and the Medical College of the University of Maryland.

Survivors: wife, Virginia Wright; daughters, Mrs. Thomas R. Poole, and Mrs. Lawrence H. Young Jr. of Charleston; son, Charles G. of Ripley; sisters, Mrs. Robert Kain of Miami Beach, Fla., Mrs. Frank Gregory of Thousand Oaks, Calif.; brother, George A. of Ravenswood.

The funeral will be Tuesday at 11 a. m. in Barlow-Bonsall Funeral Home with the Rev. Larry H. Greenwood officiating and burial in Mountain View Cemetery.
