HINTON – David Michael Lowery, 18, of Buck Route, Hinton was killed in an automobile accident on Madams Creek Road near Hinton at about 11:30 p.m. Wednesday.

Born Aug. 25, 1956, in Summers County, Lowry was a son of Amos and Betty Richmond Lowery of Buck Route, Hinton.

He was a lifelong resident of Summers County, was graduated from Hinton High School in 1974, worked with his father in the timber business and was a member of the Little Wolf Creek Baptist Church.

Other survivors include five brothers; Samuel of Pearisburg, Va., and Kenneth, Douglas, Amos Jr. and Charles all at home; six sisters, Mrs. Susan Bolling of Hinton, and Virginia, Sara, Lola, Brenda and Cathy, all at home and grandparents Mrs. Lola Lowry of Buck Route, Hinton and Mr. and Mrs. McKinley Richmond of Hinton.
