Ward C. Charlton, 40, Hinton, died at 1:40 p.m. Saturday in the Hinton Hospital where he had been a patient since Nov. 24. He had pneumonia.

Born Aug. 18, 1921, he was a son of Mr. and Mrs. O. L. Charlton, Hinton. He was employed by the Chesapeake and Ohio Railway Co. in 1945 as a fireman and was a promoted engineer.

He was a member of the Hinton Methodist Church, Brotherhood of Locomotive Firemen and Engineers and a veteran of World War II. He had lived most of his life in Hinton.

Surviving, in addition to his parents, are his wife, Mrs. Glenna Hatcher Charlton; two sons, Charles and Gary Lee, and one daughter, Mildred Ann, all at home; one sister, Dr. Mildred Williams, Charles Town; three half sisters, Mrs. Edgar Huffman and Mrs. Roscoe Amos, both of Lewisburg and Mrs. Robert McDaniel, Clifton Forge, Va.

Funeral services will be conducted at 2 p.m. Monday at the Hinton Methodist Church with the Rev. I. E. Cregger and the Rev. Fred Wyand in charge. Burial will be in the Greenbrier Burial Park.
