Warren Frederick Ellison, 79, of Prosperity, died Thursday, Aug. 22, 2002, in a Charleston area hospital.

Born March 10, 1923, in Logan County, he was the son of the late W.L. "Bill" Ellison and Ethel Grimmett Ellison.



During his earlier years he lived in Hinton, graduating from Hinton High School in 1942. He was also a graduate of Duke University in Durham, N.C.

He served in the U.S. Navy for four years.

Most of his adult life he worked in auto sales for Rhodes-Holland and Park Pontiac in Charleston and Rollyson V. Wagon Cadillac in Beckley.

He was a member of the Presbyterian Church in Beckley, and for the past 10 years he attended the Ascension Episcopal Church in Hinton.

He was preceded in death by his wife, Callie Stanley Ellison; two brothers Lonnie and Bill Ellison; two sisters, Daisy Wheeler and Gussie Harris; and nine half brothers and sisters.

Survivors include a daughter, Lynn Dickinson and husband, John; a son, Warren Frederick Ellison II; a brother, Herbert Ellison and wife, Aileen, of Hinton; and a grandson, Todd Brooks Hill of Bozeman, Mont.
