

## **Henry Clay “Skip” Price January 16, 1916 – October 10, 1979**

Mr. Henry Clay “Skip” Price, 63 of Ironton, OH, formerly of Hinton, died Wednesday at his home of an apparent heart attack.

Born in Hinton Jan. 16, 1916, he was the son of the late Henry C. and Maude Hill Price.

Mr. Price had lived in Ohio 24 years, was a member of the Central Baptist Church in Hinton and a retired mechanic for the Chessie System.

Survivors include his wife Betty Barnsgrove Price; three sons, Richard, Jeffery, and Henry, all of Ironton, OH, one brother, Allen of Charleston, WV, and one sister, Mrs. Albert (Hope) Holmes of Hinton.
