Mrs. Harriett Alexandria Whanger Read, 87, of 410 Ballengee St., died Sun. Feb. 25, in a Nashville, Tenn. hospital, following a long illness.

Born Sept. 19, 1902, at Ft. Springs, she was the daughter of the late Samuel and Annie Kean Whanger.

Mrs. Read was a long time resident of Hinton, a member of the First Presbyterian Church at Hinton, a member of the Circle No. 1 of the church, a member of the Daugh-

ters of the American Revolution and a member of the Confederacy. She also was a member of the Women of Willow Wood, the Hinton Wednesday Club, the Delphia Club and the Hinton Woman's Club.

She was preceded in death by her husband, Thomas L. Read, Nov. 21, 1976; two brothers, Alfred and Edgar Jake Whanger, and a sister, Mabel Meadows.

Survivors include a son, Thomas L. Read, Jr., of Nashville, Tenn.; a brother, Julian Whanger of Hinton; two sisters, Nina Harrison of Hinton and Alice Boone of Alexandria, Va.; two grandchildren, Thomas L. Read III and Nancy Jane Shuping, and three great-grandchildren.
