Miss Sarah Elizabeth Quisenberry, 84, of Hinton, died Tuesday February 25 in a Summers County hospital after a long illness.

Born Nov. 12, 1901, at Hinton, she was the daughter of the late Joseph Vivian and Annie Gray Quisenberry.

Miss Quisenberry was a lifelong resident of Hinton, a member of the First Christian Church in Hinton, a retired executive secretary at the Old Hinton Hospital, and was a member of the Hinton Business and Professional Woman's Club.

She was preceded in death by two sisters, Annievieve Tandy and Fannie Johnson and four brothers, Ray, George, James, and Randolph Quisenberry.

Survivors include one sister, Isabelle Murphy of Cumberland, Md., and several nieces and nephews.

Services were held Thursday February 27 at 2 p.m. at the chapel of the Ronald Meadows Funeral Parlors in Hinton with the Rev. D. D. Eiwel officiating. Burial followed in the Hilltop Cemetery.
