Mrs. Ward R. (Louise) Barlow, 79, died Wed. May 22, at a Marlinton hospital, following a short illness.

Born Apr. 10, 1912, at Hinton, she was the daughter of Edna Mae Foster of Hinton and the late A.G. Foster.

Mrs. Barlow was a homemaker and a member of the Marlinton Presbyterian Church, where she was past president of the Women of the Church. She was also a member of the Marlinton Women's Club, a 50-year member of the Home Demonstration Club, a 50-year member of the Eastern Star and was past Parade Marshall of Pioneer Days.

She was preceded in death by her husband, Ward R. Barlow I, and one brother.

Other survivors include two sons, Ward R. Barlow II and Lawrence Robert Barlow, both of Marlinton; a daughter, Lois Ann Beverage of Marlinton; a brother, Lawrence Edward Foster of Atlanta, Ga.; two sisters, Polly Goins of Hinton and Leota Higgins of Beckley; six grandchildren, and two great-grandchildren.

Services were held at 2 p.m. Fri. May 24 at the Marlinton Presbyterian Church with the Revs. Richard Newkirk and Sonny Painter officiating. Burial followed in the Cochran Cemetery.

The body was at the funeral home, where an Eastern Star service was held at 7 p.m.
