Edward E. Eckle, 73, of Hinton, died 6 p. m., Sunday, July 21, 1996, in a Hinton hospital following a short illness and his wife, Kathleen M. Eckle, 76, died 5:35 a. m. Tuesday, July 23, 1996, at her home following a long illness.

Born Jan. 11, 1923, at Sandstone, he was the son of the late Earl B. and Grace Mae Cales Eckle.

Born May 30, 1920, at Hinton, she was the daughter of the late James Henry and Mazie A. Alley Gilbert.

They resided at 604 Greenbrier Ave., Hinton. Mr. Eckle had lived most of his life in Summers County and Mrs. Eckle was a lifelong
